The most important thing is maintaining our character as a city--those qualities that make Seattle unique. Trees are a part of the character of our city and we need to preserve our tree canopy, not just replace it.
6. We do need to take a tough look at what we've been funding. It doesn't make sense to build infrastructure like light rail when we're neglecting our own streets and bridges. It's time to support the needs of taxpayers—better roads.
