Project Overview

- As part of the Levy to Move Seattle, we are paving 15th Ave W/NW and the Ballard Bridge Deck between W Emerson St to NW 57th St
- The project will restore the road condition of a critical piece of Seattle's transportation network and contribute to SDOT's Levy commitment to pave up to 180 lane-miles of arterial streets by 2024
- This project will also improve earthquake safety by strengthening the Leary Way Bridge, located just north of the Ballard Bridge

Project Elements

Paving & Bridge Maintenance

- Pave 15th Ave W/NW from W Emerson St to NW 57th St
- Improve earthquake safety on the bridge and replace worn out bridge expansion joints

Rapid D Line bus reliability

Add new "bus only" lanes and markings in select areas

General improvements

- Repair sidewalks, driveways, and stormwater drainage
- Plant new trees and replace old trees in select areas



Project Elements Continued

Safety & Accessibility Enhancements

- Install a new bike and pedestrian signal and crosswalk at NW 51st St
- Add landscaped median between NW 50th St and NW 54th St to calm traffic
- Upgrade curb ramps to meet current ADA standards
- Update pedestrian crosswalk signs and refresh paint
- Improve / add new lighting under the bridge along Leary Way NW and on the pedestrian path under 15th Ave W near 15th Ave W and W Nickerson St

- Construction is scheduled to begin as soon as spring 2024.
- Construction will last approximately one year.
- Changes in construction timeline may be due to unforeseen circumstances (i.e., weather, soil conditions, etc.)

Pre-Construction & Community Outreach

- Pre-construction means we will be staging equipment and materials in the project corridor
- The contractor may do some prep-work such as implementing traffic control plans to create a safe work zone
- We're engaging businesses through door-todoor efforts and providing relevant information to the community on our project listserv and webpage updates

What to Expect During Road Construction

- Temporary lane and street closures for people driving and during outside construction hours
- Temporary vehicle and bus detours
- Temporary sidewalk and crossing closures and detours for people walking and rolling
- Temporary bus stop relocations
- Disruptions to on-street parking
- Noise, dust and vibrations during work hours (generally Monday – Friday, 7 AM – 4 PM)
- Construction staging and parking impacts near the work sites
- Occasional night or weekend work, as needed



What to Expect During Bridge Construction

- Weekend bridge closures (TBD)
- Pedestrian, bicycle, vehicle, and bus detours to the Fremont Bridge and Aurora Bridge
- Noise, dust and vibrations during work hours (generally Monday – Friday, 7 AM – 4 PM)
- Construction staging and parking impacts near the work sites
- Occasional night or weekend work, as needed



Using Community Feedback for Detour Planning

- We spoke with the Ballard PTSA / High School and Seattle Public Schools and will continue to coordinate with them
- We collected feedback on preferred detour routes in 2023 and based on what we heard we are detouring people to the Fremont and Aurora Bridges during Ballard Bridge work
- We are coordinating with the Route 40 team to ensure the Fremont bridge stays accessible during Ballard Bridge work

Next steps

- We sent the construction contract to AD so contractors can bid on the project
- Once a contractor is selected, we will work with them to develop a construction schedule that includes work zones and bridge closure dates
- We're coordinating with nearby schools, King County Metro and emergency services to prepare them for construction activities and possible detour routes
- We'll encourage people to take alternative modes of transportation to reduce congestion
